INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:

Just before 4:30 p.m. firefighters responded to a report by a Midpeninsula Regional Open Space employee of a vehicle over a 100 foot embankment. Upon arrival, crews found the vehicle involved in fire, spreading to the vegetation.

Crews located the driver of the vehicle, who had sustained moderate injuries and worked to bring them back to the roadway where they were transferred to an ambulance and transported to an area hospital. The driver was confirmed to be the only occupant of the vehicle. However, due to a language barrier, it is unknown if the driver was ejected or self-extricated from the vehicle before responders arrived.

One structure was threatened by the vegetation fire, but crews were able to stop the progress of the fire and contain it quickly.

The cause of the vehicle accident is unknown, crews will remain on scene for full extinguishment and cleanup of the fire area.
