INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:

At approximately 2:45 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department and San Jose Fire Department were dispatched to reports of a structure fire on the 12300 block of Kosich Place in Saratoga.

On arrival, crews found heavy smoke and fire coming from a single story residence. A second alarm was requested and one resident was rescued from the home.

Firefighters quickly controlled the fire involving the structure, and monitored fire from a ruptured gas line adjacent to the home for approximately 90 minutes, until PG&E could safely shut off the supply. The residence sustained fire damage to the garage, attic, and exterior wall, and smoke damage throughout.

No injuries to residents or firefighters were reported. Two residents were displaced by the fire. Crews will remain on scene for cleanup; cause of the fire is under investigation but is not considered suspicious.
