## INCIDENT SUMMARY

<b>Incident Summary:</b>	<p>At approximately 11:14 a.m. Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to reports of a structure fire in a storage building in the area of the 1100 block of Dell Avenue in Campbell. Crews reported smoke visible while responding and, on arrival, firefighters found a single story plus loft level detached outbuilding involved in fire. Crews assisted one person on site to safety and confirmed that no occupants were inside the building.</p> <p>Spread of fire to adjacent buildings was prevented and the fire was brought under control at 12:15 p.m. The building sustained extensive fire damage and crews remain on scene for full extinguishment, cleanup and investigation.</p> <p>Materials stored in the structure were not found to be hazardous, the cause of the fire is under investigation.</p>
<b>Road Closures:</b>	Dell Avenue has reopened to through traffic.
